Prof Langan is a Wellcome Senior Clinical Fellow and Professor of Clinical Epidemiology at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine (LSHTM). She also works as an honorary consultant dermatologist at St John's Institute of Dermatology, Guy's and St Thomas' hospital London. She is Associate Director for HDR-UK London.

She trained in Medicine at the Queen's University of Belfast, completed her PhD at the University of Nottingham and gained post-doctoral experience at the University of Pennsylvania.

She leads a large collaborative international programme of work using the power of electronic medical record and administrative data to provide answers for important research questions related to a range of skin diseases. She also leads programmes focusing on understanding gene-environment interactions in eczema and my work is contributing to programmes on stratified medicine in eczema. She is co-founder and co-Chair of the REporting of studies Conducted using Observational Routinely collected Data (RECORD) initiative (www.record-statement.org). She is former Chair of the European Dermatoepidemiology Network Steering committee (www.orgs.dermis.net/eden) and has a range of active local, national and international collaborative projects using data from Denmark, Norway and the USA.
